We hope you and your loved ones are staying safe and healthy in these challenging times. Although it has been a routine-disrupting year, the cycles of the seasons are reassuring in their constancy. With the leaves long down, a light blanket of snow has settled onto the forest, combining the restfulness of late fall with the magic of winter—and signaling the time for us to start harvesting wreath greens.

We're excited to bundle up, harvest greens in the cold and quiet forest, warm up by the wood stove, and then head down to our workshop to weave the evergreens into a lush wreath. This year we'll be joined by a third wreathmaker, Carlisle, who has been the artist-in-residence (singer-songwriter) working on Round River Farm this season.

We invite you to bring this microcosm of the North Woods into your home by ordering one of our wreaths or mailing one directly to a friend as a gift. We also hope you'll enjoy the taste of fall with some of the wild rice we hand harvested from the lakes of Central Minnesota. This year you may notice that the wild rice has a lighter color and nuttier flavor, since we switched to a more traditional wood-fired processor. We are grateful for the bounty of our precious lakes and rivers.

Fresh Handmade Balsam Wreaths

We hand-weave our wreaths from fresh balsam, pine, and cedar sustainably harvested from our surrounding forests, and decorate with pinecones, princess pine, imitation berries, and a weatherproof red velvet bow. We think of them as a circular forest because they incorporate so many pieces of our beautiful surrounding woods. They measure approximately 24" in diameter and will be shipped out starting the last week of November unless you specify otherwise.

Minnesota Wild Rice

We hand harvest our wild rice from the lakes and rivers of Northern Minnesota. This is not the same as most commercial "wild" rice found in stores, which has been farmed in monoculture paddies. True Minnesota wild rice grows naturally in shallow lakes and rivers where it is harvested by using long sticks to bend over the stalks and knock the ripe grain into the bottom of a canoe. This is then parched and threshed at a mill. The result is a nutty flavor full of the richness and variety provided by our native wetlands. Add a wild rice package to a wreath or order some separately. Recipes are included.
